COURSE CONTENT

The 2-day course will provide attendees with an understanding of the fundamentals and practical applications involved in gold processing including mineralogy, gravity separation, cyanide and other leaching agents, CIP unit operations, cyanide management and reporting, refractory and complex ore treatment and circuit optimisation. Participants will have the opportunity to discuss their plant practices and problems.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

The workshop is designed to provide practising metallurgists with knowledge and tools to assist in operation and optimisation of gold processing circuits. Plant metallurgists, senior metallurgists, consultants and design engineers new to, or already working in, the gold industry who wish to upgrade or renew their knowledge in practical gold processing. The course will also benefit professionals in related disciplines including mining engineering, and environmental managers who wish to further their knowledge of gold processing.
